



Our assessment day is designed to make your daughter feel as relaxed as possible, so it is an enjoyable day in a classroom environment to enable us to see her true potential.

The day will consist of the following:

- Mathematical activities, including word problems
- English activities, including reading, writing and comprehension
- Problem solving and cognitive ability games.

Mathematics

Pupils should have knowledge of mathematical vocabulary, concepts and strategies appropriate to their current year group, including number bonds, ordering, counting, patterns and calculations. At all stages of entry, we are looking for accuracy and efficiency to demonstrate their mathematical understanding. Pupils should also have the skills to apply their knowledge to solve problems which will be within their mathematical experience.



English

Pupils should be able to read as fluently as possible with understanding and enjoyment, recognising and blending sounds independently and confidently at an age appropriate level. They will be asked to demonstrate their understanding through discussion of texts and through written comprehension questions.

Writing:

Pupils will be asked to plan a piece of writing, demonstrating the skills appropriate to their current year group, including structuring the piece clearly, using age-appropriate spelling and punctuation accurately and including descriptive vocabulary.

Problem Solving and Cognitive Ability Games:

Pupils will experience some puzzles and challenge games through which they can demonstrate their creative and logical approach to thinking activities and their resilience when puzzles don't have an immediate answer.

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
